Online application Steps

Step 1

Visit the RFMCF website at www.rfmcf.co.za.

Step 2

Click on "Apply for Membership" on the top right hand corner of the website as shown on the image above.

Step 3

Follow the easy prompts by completing your details online. To move to the next page, simply click "next" until you have completed all the necessary information required.

Step 4

Upload all the necessary documentation and press "submit".

Step 5

Check your mailbox as you will receive an email as confirmation of the application form. Once the application form has been processed and activated, you will receive a link to upload your membership card online through the Fund's RFMCF Mobi App.

Did you know?

- The principal member must have contributed 10+ years towards the RFMCF to qualify for membership.
- The aim of the RFMCF is to provide continued medical, dental, and hospital treatment through the South African Military Health Services (SAMHS) to members and their registered dependants.
- The RFMCF, along with its Administrator, the Professional Provident Society Healthcare Administrator (PPSHA), manages the healthcare benefits, contributions and claims to ensure that it is ethically processed in accordance with the rules of the Fund.
- The SAMHS is responsible for providing medical care to all beneficiaries of the Fund. If the necessary services to treat medical conditions are not available within the SAMHS, this may then be outsourced by the SAMHS.
